

Basketball Tournament Rules

Games are: Two - 16 minute halves, continuous clock until the last minute of the game.
- Clock remains continuous if 15-point lead.
Three- 30 second time outs per game.
2 minute halftime

Overtime Rules: sudden death – first point wins – no time outs.

Championship Game – 1 minute overtime. Clock stops for each dead ball. No time outs.

Pressing rules: 5th-8th grade pressing allowed anytime as long as the pressing team does not have a 20 point lead.

3rd-4th grade – only during last two minutes of each half and OT as long as pressing team does not have a 15 point lead

Defensive rules: No ½ court zone defenses for 5th grade and under unless team is behind by 15 points. Help/recover is considered man-man.

Balls used: Please bring warm-up balls. A 29.5 ball will be used for 7th grade boys and up unless both coaches want to use 28.5.

Mercy rule: Referees will call the game at 2:00 if there is a 20 point or more lead

Only the HEAD COACH may stand and coach (within the coach's area). Assistant coaches cannot stand or talk to the referees during games.

A player may only play on one team during the tournament unless the two teams are from the same program and in different divisions. Permission from the tournament director is required.

Technical fouls – results in 2 points, and the ball out of bounds.

If a player or coach is ejected it is the discretion of the referees and tournament director if the ejected player or coach may be allowed to watch.

If a spectator is ejected from a game they must leave the playing/spectator area for the remainder of the game. They may return to the next game at the discretion of the tourney director and/or referees.

Absolutely no pre-game dunking. No hanging on the rim on in-game dunks. These will both be enforced as technical fouls.

Any profanity and taunting will result in an immediate technical foul. No warnings.

All other rules to follow the IHSAU and IGHS AU.

FREE THROWS – 5th grade/under go up to the second line

Admission is \$8 (under 5 free)

Each team to provide a scorekeeper/clock operator per game.

Rosters/waiver must be submitted prior to the first game.

Tie breaker rules – head to head, defensive points allowed, offensive points scored, coin flip.

No shooting on the courts during halftimes and time-outs other than by the teams competing in that particular game.
